### Eric Martin, Age 7 Kennewick

Eric Martin was born with a cataract in his left eye. Unfortunately, the cataract was not diagnosed until age 4. As a result, he developed amblyopia in his left eye. Even after cataract surgery, the amblyopia left him with extremely poor vision (20/300) and no depth perception. This prevented Eric from being able to play ball, ride a bike or identify letters and numbers.



The good news is that some of Eric's vision has been restored through vision therapy with Cory Manley, O.D. In fact, now in the first grade, Eric sees 20/40 in his left eye and has regained up to 200' of depth perception. That means he's developing more self esteem and is out playing ball with his friends!
